

Grading system at Warsaw School of Economics (SGH)

From 2012/2013 academic year, SGH has changed its grading scale by deleting the 5.5 (the highest) grade. Therefore, the grading percentage of current 5.0 grade represents accumulated percentage of former 5.0 and 5.5 grades. The ECTS grading table that reflects the actual distribution of grades under new system will be updated in May 2013.

In a new system, the grading scale used at SGH from that academic year ranges from 2.0 to 5.0.

- 5.0 is the highest grade and the lowest passing grade is 3.0.
- 4.0 is the norm for a good pass.
